






## SEEME, HEAR ME NEWSLETTER 4



As we move towards the last semester of the **SeHeMe Project (Project Number: 2022-1-PT02-KA220-YOU-000087351)**, project results are progressing with the combined effort and collaboration among all partners!

First and foremost, **the SeHeMe Case Studies Booklet** has been finalised under the lead of the coordinator, Lusofona University - COFAC from Portugal with the contribution of all partners. After interviewing migrants and collecting their narratives, partners turned them into stories that demonstrate the successful integration to the society of the host country. As a result, 14 case studies have been collected. They describe the various motivations of young migrants to migrate, the challenges encountered in the host countries and how these were overcome. Secondly, all partners have been working on the Foreign Language for Media Literacy e-course under the lead of Eurospeak from Ireland and the co-lead of PADIL from Tunisia. 
